SUBJECT: Toxic Substance Control Act (TSCA) Compliance Statement

To whom it may concern:

This document is Reed Switch Developments Corporation's (RSD) statement regarding the Toxic Substance Control Act (TSCA).

We are committed to working towards eliminating environmentally hazardous substances throughout our business operations to the extent possible. We take our responsibility under applicable environmental legislation, regulations, and guidelines very seriously, as such RSD is fulfilling our due diligence by surveying our supplier base with regard to the existence of these chemicals in our supply chain. Any information contained in this letter is based upon information provided by the applicable suppliers of materials and products to RSD.

Please note that RSD does not conduct an independent analysis of the chemical composition of any parts or products provided by our suppliers.

The EPA, through the TSCA, has now restricted the following PBT chemicals within the applications of manufacture (including import), processing, and/or distribution.

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE): A flame retardant in plastic enclosures for televisions, computers, audio and video equipment, textiles and upholstered articles, wire and cables for communication and electronic equipment, and other applications.
- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1)): A plasticizer, a flame retardant, an anti-wear additive, or an anti-compressibility additive in hydraulic fluid, lubricating oils, lubricants and greases, various industrial coatings, adhesives, sealants, and plastic articles.
- 2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl) phenol (2,4,6-TTBP): An intermediate/reactant in processing, and is incorporated into formulations destined for fuel and fuel-related additives;
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD): A chemical used as a halogenated aliphatic hydrocarbon that is produced as a byproduct during the manufacture of chlorinated hydrocarbons.
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP): A chemical used to make rubber more pliable in industrial uses.

At the time of this statement, and to the best of our knowledge, the above chemicals are not present in any materials or components currently in use in our products, or the manufacture thereof.

Please note that the information provided in this letter should not be considered to be a warranty or quality specification. Any warranties relating to the quality of a product supplied to you will be set forth in mutually agreed terms and conditions between RSD and your company.
